american history volume 1 surveys the broad sweep of american history from the first native american societies to the end of the reconstruction period following the civil war drawing on a deep range of research and years of classroom teaching experience thomas s kidd offers students an engaging overview of the first half of american history the volume features illuminating stories of people from well known presidents and generals to lesser known men and women who struggled under slavery and other forms of oppression to make their place in american life the role of christianity in america is central in this book americans faith sometimes inspired awakenings and the search for an equitable society but at other times it justified violence and inequality students will come away from american history volume 1 better prepared to grapple with the challenges presented by the history of america s founding the problem of slavery and our nation s political tradition

this 1893 survey ranks among the most important books about the impact of frontier life on u s society it examines the frontier s role in promoting self reliance independence democracy immigration and westward expansion

the gretest eras in american history described by famous writers from columbus to wilson is an editorial work by american journalist and historian francis w halsey the aim has been to present striking accounts of periods in the history of the united states from the landing of columbus to the building of the foundation of the first colonies in large part events are described by men who participated in them or were personal eye witnesses of them these accounts are often supplemented by passages from the writings of historians and biographers first volume deals with voyages of discovery and early explorations from around 1000 a d to 1682 second volume ii deals with the planting of the first colonies in the period from 1562 to 1733

before this book first appeared in 1963 most historians wrote as if the continental expansion of the united states were inevitable what is most impressive henry steele commager and richard morris declared in 1956 is the ease the simplicity and seeming inevitability of the whole process the notion of inevitability however is perhaps only a secular variation on the theme of the expansionist editor john l o sullivan who in 1845 coined one of the most famous phrases in american history when he wrote of our manifest destiny to overspread the continent allotted by providence for the free development of our yearly multiplying millions frederick merk rejected inevitability in favor of a more contingent interpretation of american expansionism in the 1840s as his student henry may later recalled merk loved to get the facts straight from the foreword by john mack faragher

covering a broad chronology from the colonial era to the present this volume s 28 chapters reflect the diverse approaches interests and findings of an international group of new and established scholars working on american crime histories today the book is organized around major themes in crime history including violence science and technology culture gender and organized crime and it addresses pressing contemporary concerns such as mass incarceration and the racial politics of crime in modern america it also engages with the history of crime literature film and popular culture from colonial execution sermons to true crime television in the twenty first century the volume is alert to continuities and diversity over time and place in the history of american crime notably in chapters on the south the west and the impact of urbanization on practices and ideas about crime and law enforcement in different periods of the american past the routledge history of crime in america is an indispensable interdisciplinary resource for students and researchers working in areas of crime crime policy punishment policing and incarceration

in comparison to such regions as the south the far west and new england the midwest and its culture have been neglected both by scholars and by the popular press historians as well as literary and art critics tend not to examine the midwest in depth in their academic work and in the popular imagination the midwest has never really ascended to the level of the proud literary south the cultured democratic northeast or the hip innovative west coast finding a new midwestern history revives and identifies anew the midwest as a field of study by promoting a diversity of viewpoints and lending legitimacy to a more in depth rigorous scholarly assessment of a large region of the united states that has largely been overlooked by scholars the essays discuss facets of midwestern life worth examining more deeply including history religion geography art race culture and politics and are written by well known scholars in the field such as michael allen jon butler and nicole etcheson

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this three volume encyclopedia on the history of american food and beverages serves as an ideal companion resource for social studies and american history courses covering topics ranging from early american indian foods to mandatory nutrition information at fast food restaurants the expression you are what you eat certainly applies to americans not just in terms of our physical health but also in the myriad ways that our taste preferences eating habits and food culture are intrinsically tied to our society and history this standout reference work comprises two volumes containing more than 600 alphabetically arranged historical entries on american foods and beverages as well as dozens of historical recipes for traditional american foods and a third volume of more than 120 primary source documents never before has there been a reference work that coalesces this diverse range of information into a single set the entries in this set provide information that will transform any american history research project into an engaging learning experience examples include explanations of how tuna fish became a staple food product for americans how the canning industry emerged from the civil war the difference between americans and people of other countries in terms of what percentage of their income is spent on food and beverages and how taxation on beverages like tea rum and whisky set off important political rebellions in u s history

it seems to be a tenet of the human condition to perceive others as different and potentially hostile in nearly all societies stereotypes are developed to stigmatize suspected enemies within and without the american case is particularly interesting in this respect because american society consists of nothing but others to be open to others and welcome those who are different is one of the basic tenets of the country however this principle often conflicts with the need to integrate all these strangers into a homogeneous governable society which causes the formation of hostile stereotypes of certain ethnic groups that do not fit in the authors in this volume look at the development of these enemy images which form a fairly consistent pattern from the period of the american revolution to the post world war ii era in doing so they focus on the question of to what extent these enemy images influence the formulation and outcome of foreign domestic and immigration policies

provides the key source materialshistorical and legalfor understanding the relationship of church and state the controversies surrounding aid to parochial schools blue laws school prayer and birth control programs have been central to the ongoing search for the proper boundary between religious and political authority in america this concise volume features chronologically organized selections from such official documents as colonial charters court opinions and legislation along with incisive twentieth century interpretations of the issues they treat historical figures as diverse as john f kennedy perry miller reinhold niebhur and paul blanshard together with contemporary ones illuminate the interrelationships between the legal political and religious structures of american society we encounter controversies every day that concern school vouchers prayer in schools and stadiums religious symbols in public spaces and tax support for faith based social initiatives as well as arguments among advocates of pro choice and pro life positions these and other issues are at the center of an ongoing search for a means to delineate the interactions among religious and political authorities initially in the united states but increasingly in the rest of the world as well this concise volume presents chronologically organized chapters that include selections from documents like colonial charters opinions of the supreme court and salient legislation along with contemporary commentary and incisive interpretations of the issues by modern scholars figures as divergent as john winthrop john f kennedy and sandra day oconnor speak from these pages as directly as paul blanshard reinhold niebuhr john courtney murray and robert

bellah church and state in american history addresses the difficult relationships among the political and religious structures of our society and the emergence of an american solution to the church state problem

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
