edited by an expert team from the open university and written by a broad range of contributors this book draws on a wealth of experience in this popular subject area it will be a key text for students of forensic psychology counselling and psychotherapy and for health and social care professionals working in therapeutic and forensic settings

forensic psychiatry has expanded over the last twenty years with a dramatic increase in forensic psychiatry posts and medium secure unit beds there has been increased concern with the treatment which is seen by many to be of great importance and management of mentally ill offenders which has led to more interest in understanding

forensic psychotherapy explores the roots of violent sexual and antisocial behaviour it is a relatively recently created discipline that applies psychoanalytic knowledge to the assessment management and treatment of mentally disordered offenders forming a bridge between traditional forensic psychiatry with its focus on diagnosis and risk and traditional psychotherapy with its focus on understanding why things happen as a discipline forensic psychotherapy seeks to understand the conscious and unconscious motivations that underpin specific offending behaviours we need to understand not only the detail of the crime but also the offender as a whole person within his environment including the criminal justice environment it aims to understand the perpetrator the victim and the victim within the perpetrator in this collection leading international experts in forensic psychotherapy explore the different aspects and developments within the field these include first hand experiences of shaping the emerging discipline within the uk europe and the united states working therapeutically with high risk offenders in prisons and secure hospitals exploration of female violence and work with incarcerated mothers and babies and the latest developments in forensic psychotherapy training this book will be of interest to professionals and academics working within the fields of forensic mental health criminal justice psychiatry psychology criminology and sociology this book was originally published as two special issues of psychoanalytic psychotherapy

from the nothing works maxim of the 1970s to evidence based interventions to challenge recidivism and promote pro social behavior psychological therapy has played an important role in rehabilitation and risk reduction within forensic settings in recent years and yet the typical group therapy model isn't always the appropriate path to take in this important new book the aims and effectiveness of individual therapies within forensic settings both old and new are assessed and discussed including contributions from authors based in the uk north america europe australia and new zealand a broad range of therapies are covered including cognitive behavioural therapy mentalisation based therapy schema therapy acceptance and commitment therapy and compassion focussed therapy each chapter provides an assessment of the evidence base for effectiveness the adaptations required in a forensic setting whether the therapy is aimed at recidivism or psychological change the client or patient characteristics it is aimed at a case study of the therapy in action the final section of the book looks at ethical issues the relationship between individual and group based treatment therapist supervision and deciding which therapies and therapists to select this book is essential reading for probation staff psychologists criminal justice and liaison workers and specialist treatment staff it will also be a valuable resource for any student of forensic or clinical psychology

this book brings together recent research developments in relating theory it is divided into four parts which introduce the reader to relating theory how it has developed and how it can be applied to clinical and forensic psychology topics include how couples relate to one another how young people relate to their parents how assessments of relating can be used in therapy how specific negative relating styles relate to offending behaviour risk taking and alcohol use psychopathic and sadistic tendencies and how the interpersonal relating of offenders can change during treatment in prison the book covers international research involving both quantitative and qualitative methods and will be of interest to clinicians academics and both undergraduate and postgraduate students in the fields of psychology clinical psychology forensic criminal psychology psychiatry psychotherapy counselling art therapy and mental health

hmp holloway was the largest women s prison in europe historically holding numerous infamous female criminals and eliciting intrigue and fascination from the public the end of the sentence psychotherapy with female offenders documents the rich and varied psychotherapeutic work undertaken by dedicated specialists in this intense and often difficult environment where attempts to provide psychological security were often undermined by conflicting ideas of physical security women commit crime most often in the context of poverty addiction and transgenerational violence or trauma familial cycles of offending and imprisonment which are often overlooked using personal testimony and case studies and screened through the lens of psychoanalytic theory the book examines the enduring therapeutic and relational endeavour to find connection closure and to experience a good enough ending with prisoners when the possibility of a positive new beginning often seemed remote it also considers how the cultural and political discourse remains hostile towards women who are incarcerated and how this may have culminated in the closure of the only female prison in london through insightful real life accounts this insightful book also emphasizes the importance of professionals finding ways of supporting one another to offer women who have entered the criminal justice system a way to leave it it will prove fascinating reading for forensic psychotherapists forensic psychologists and criminologists as well as anything interested in the criminal justice system

how can environments play a role in assisting and sustaining personal change in individuals incarcerated within the criminal justice system can a failure to address contextual issues reduce or undermine the effectiveness of clinical intervention bringing together a range of leading forensic psychologists this book explores and illustrates inter relationships between interventions and the environment in which they take place this book examines how the environment can be better utilised to contribute to processes of change and how therapeutic principles and practices can be more strongly embedded through being applied in supportive facilitative environments in addition it expands on emerging conceptualisations of how psychological functioning and environmental context are inextricably linked and offers an alternative to prevailing intrapsychic or essentialist views of areas such as personality and cognition providing new and challenging insights and perspectives on issues of central relevance to forensic psychology and related disciplines this book contributes to the development of innovative and unifying directions for research practice and theory this book will be an essential resource for those who work with or intend

building exercises is available new to the second edition chapters have been reorganized to emphasize the importance of counselors creating an alliance with offenders discussions have been updated on topics such as multicultural counseling counseling victims counseling paraprofessionals cognitive behavioral counseling multimodal counseling brief counseling and counseling outcome effectiveness new chapters have been added on counseling criminal psychopaths the role of emotions in the counseling process counseling male and female offenders and the relationship between trauma addiction and human behavior primarily designed for criminal justice students taking correctional counseling courses counseling criminal justice offenders second edition is also a vital resource for any criminal justice social work psychology or counseling practitioner interfacing with offenders

there is an expectation that women will be nurturers and carers women who have been judged violent destructive and criminal and who are detained in the criminal justice system can find themselves perceived through a distorted lens as unwomanly this book explains how they become hypervisible in their difference while the histories of trauma and suffering that are communicated through their offending and other risk behaviour remain hidden and so are unseen bringing together authors uniquely placed as experts in their fields invisible trauma argues that it is essential to trace the traumatic roots of women s violence and criminality powerful intergenerational factors perpetuate the cycles of offending and trauma re enactment that current sentencing practice overlooks the authors present a psychoanalytically informed account of the development of violence and other offending identifying pathways for change to address trauma within the lives of these women and their children and also to create a responsive effective and sensitive workforce invisible trauma highlights the role of emotional social and cultural forces in traumatising women who come into contact with the criminal justice system and uncovers areas of their lives that are all too often hidden from view it will be invaluable to those working in clinical and forensic psychology mental health nursing psychotherapy social work medical practice and women s health as well as frontline practitioners in the criminal justice system the health service and third sector organisations and for anyone with an interest in racism equality and social justice
